I am writing to you with regards to the Ocean Road Facility and in support of the City of Mandurah's funding application to the National Rugby League "Football Facilities Fund".

Mandurah Storm Rugby League Club was established in 2013. Our registrations have grown annually from 80 participants in the first year to 220 in 2017. Mandurah Storm offers teams in every age group of the NRL WA Junior Smarter Than Smoking competition with multiple teams in some younger grades.

The current facility used by the club makes it very difficult for the club to reach its full potential. With the anticipated growth over the next 2-3 years, this being the introduction of an Under 18's and Senior Third grade side in 2018, Tindale Reserve does not have the capacity to accommodate such changes or participation growth. Currently there is nothing more than a shipping container and toilets which are located at an adjoining school. To be able to provide our members and visiting Clubs the level of service when hosting junior and senior sides that can also accommodate and increasing female participation base we need to provide facilities that meet everyone's requirements and expectations.

Mandurah Storm strives to be a family focused club and the possibility of relocating to the new Ocean Road Facility and to have a Home to build on is such an exciting prospect. This would allow us to develop stronger professional business development behaviours targeting regular functions, events and fundraising opportunities that would benefit the local Community and the clubs long term sustainability on and off the field.
