Just so we are all on the same page please see below regarding some notes that need to be shared with all Teams within the Communities -

### **Key Notes –**

#### Pre-Harmony Cup –

- All Players, Coaches, Sports Trainers, League Safe, Managers need to be registered by the 29/11/2018. (Last Chance)
- Each Team is to supply their Team List/Squad by the 29/11/2018. (Last Chance)
- Final Team Payments are due by the 29/11/2018. (Last Chance)
- The final draw has been sent out and can be viewed on our Facebook page or web site

#### Game Day – Team Info

- A reminder that the Opening Ceremony is on Saturday the 1<sup>st</sup> of December and all Communities and their Teams are required to attend, please arrive between 7.45am – 8.10am, and the Cook Island Drums will welcome the Teams onto the field from 8.10am - 8.14am, with Opening Ceremony starting at 8.15am and concluding at 8.45am.
- All Under 16's players (Boys and Girls) are required to attend the Voice Against Violence Workshop between 9.30am – 11.30am on Saturday the 1<sup>st</sup> of December. The Under 14's Boys Team from the Tokelau Community will also be attending this workshop.
- All Teams will have access to 10 x 5kg bags of Ice at the event, it is a cost of \$10 per Team, and any addition bags can be purchased for \$2. Ice will be available for Friday – Sunday and you will not have to pick up your 10 bags in one go.
- Please note that Players and Team Management are the only ones allowed in the Team Marquees (which are located near the Player Welfare Stations) and in the middle of the playing fields, all supporters should be located on the opposite side or along sides of the playing fields or in the Grand Stands.
- All Teams are required to be on the field and ready to play (i.e. 2min) before the kick off times, this way we will be able to complete Team War Dance (e.g. Haka) at the start of the game.
- If a Team is more than 4min late for the start of their game it will be classed as a forfeit, and their opponent will be awarded the game points as per stated in the Competition Hand Book.
- All Team sheets are to be signed by the Players, Team Manager, the Opposition Team Manager and the Game Referee, before handed in to the Event Administration, please note you will have 1 hour after each game to hand in the Team Sheet.

##### Game Day – Team Info cont.

- Refer to the Site Map for Warm Up space, Maps have been provided to each Team Manager, and they are displayed near the Results Boards on both sides of the Club House.
- Results will be displayed on both sides of the Club House, so people will be able to see the progress of each Grade.
- Please refer to the Competition Hand Book for the Laws of Game.
- Heat monitoring will be conducted throughout set times across the 3 days, if a game or games are not able to be played due to High Heat levels, the game will be classed as a Draw and both teams will be given competition points.
- If any Extra Ordinary Weather Conditions occur NRL WA will advise and implant procedures as required.
- All Judiciary matters will be dealt with at the Tournament and on the day the incident.
- Ball Kids are encouraged to be attached to all Teams with in your Community.
- We have Player Welfare Stations located near the playing fields and our trained Sports Trainers can assist with all first aid requirements, for both Player or Spectators. If an injury does occur that requires immediate or additional medical assistance the NRL WA officials will call an Ambulance.

##### Event Info –

- Please **NO Commercial FOOD or DRINKS** should be brought into the event, we have Community Food Stalls & the Rockingham Canteen with plenty of tasty treats for purchase across the 3 days. As a condition of entry bags, Eskies/Chilly Bins can be checked by event officials.
- Home made food is allowed at the event and can be brought in.
- The Rockingham Sharks will be selling Alcohol at the event through their Bar, so please be aware of the Alcohol Zones. Please be aware under **NO CIRCUMSTANCES** is alcohol to be brought into the Event, breaches could lead to further action involving the Police.
- Please note this is a **NON-SMOKING** Event/Venue, so please be aware of where the smoking zones are located.
